- 1. The Advisory Body (AD) can suggest to Faculty the updating of study programs, in order to ensure that students receive adequate professional preparation in accordance with market demands.
- 2. Members of the AD can support the implementation of professional practice for students, in line with the study programs, and can assess the learning outcomes of students, if required.
- 3. The AD supports Faculty and the labor market in related fields of activity, in creating joint working groups.
- 4. The AD and Faculty cooperate in the field of scientific research, professional services, intermediation for innovation, as well as in proposals for joint projects with Faculty and other partners.
- 5. AD members may be guest lecturers for Faculty courses, offer scholarships for students, and provide financial support for student and academic staff research projects.
- 6. AD members may be members of the commission for distributing scholarships for students and/or evaluating student achievements if required by the Academic Unit.
- 7. Depending on the activities of Faculty, the AD can also consider other matters proposed by the Dean.
- 8. At the invitation of the Dean, the Chairman of the AD may present the activities of the Council to the Faculty and the Accreditation Agency of Kosovo (AKA) for a certain period, or request for new study programs or improvement of existing ones.
- 9. In the case of accreditation and re-accreditation of study programs, if the Accreditation Agency of Kosovo (AKA) requests a meeting with the Chairman of the AD, the Chairman of the AD will meet with AKA experts after consulting with Faculty management.
